The following shall be considered as incorporated into the project plans and specifications for the above referenced project. Portions of Contract Documents not specifically mentioned in this Addendum remain in force.


ADDENDA

1. In "Section 6-7.1.1 Specified Contract Time" of the Special Conditions the sentence which reads "The Contractor shall complete the work within Two Hundred Ninety Five (295) working days starting with the commencement date specified in the Notice to Proceed." is hereby changed to read "**The Contractor shall complete the work within Two Hundred Ten (210) working days starting with the commencement date specified in the Notice to Proceed.**"
2. In "Section 6-9 Liquidated Damages" of the Special Conditions the sentence which reads "For each successive working day in excess of the time provided for the completion of work, as specified in Section 6-7 herein and as adjusted in accordance with Section 6-6 of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, the Contractor shall pay to the City, or have withheld from monies due it, the sum of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty (\$6,750)." is hereby changed to read "**For each successive working day in excess of the time provided for the completion of work, as specified in Section 6-7 herein and as adjusted in accordance with Section 6-6 of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, the Contractor shall pay to the City, or have withheld from monies due it, the sum of Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty (\$9,720).**"
