**THIS EXPEDITED REVIEW INFORMATION IS TO BE USED ONLY FOR SMALL RESIDENTIAL PV  
SYSTEMS WHICH ARE 10 KW OR LESS**

A City Building Permit is required for photovoltaic (PV) power systems. For residential expediting purposes, Planning Division approval will not be necessary.

As a permit applicant you need to complete and submit the City Building Permit application form along with two copies of plans, documents and the necessary plan check fees. Permit fees will be due at the time of permit issuance.

To be considered a complete PV project submittal, basic design information will be needed. The system is to comply with all the applicable sections of the current version of the California Electrical, Fire and Building Codes.

Criteria for submitting plan(s) and checklist(s) should substantially conform to the checklist(s) and standard plan(s) contained in the most current version of the California Solar Permitting Guidebook, Part 3. Below is the web address for the most current version at the date of this filing.
