



## Project Acknowledgement and Photographs

The City of Highland acknowledges the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for helping to fund rehabilitation of streets in Highland.

CalRecycle provides the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program, formerly called the [Rubberized Asphalt Concrete \(RAC\) Grant Program](#), to promote markets for recycled-content surfacing products derived from waste tires generated in California and decrease the adverse environmental impacts created by unlawful disposal and stockpiling of waste tires. [RAC](#) is a proven road paving material that has been used in California since the 1970s. It is made by blending ground tire rubber with asphalt binder which is then mixed with conventional aggregate materials.

Under the Pavement Grant Program, the Targeted RAC Incentive Grant and RAC Chip Seal Grant have been consolidated into one grant with two project types - RAC and Chip Seal projects. The program is designed to encourage first-time or limited users of rubberized pavement.

In 2011, CalRecycle awarded \$250,000 in RAC grant funds to the City of Highland for rehabilitation of streets in Highland. In March of 2013, the City of Highland, in association with the City of San Bernardino, San Bernardino Association of Governments (SANBAG), and Cal Recycle, completed the rehabilitation work on two projects which included recycling a total of **25,831** waste tires into the roadway pavement on the following streets.

- **Boulder Avenue** from Highland Avenue to Base Line
- **Highland Avenue** from Summertrail Place to Surrey lane and from Church Street to Cloverhill Drive
- **Church Street** from Highland Avenue to Greenspot Road
- **Weaver Street** from Greenspot Road to Base Line
- **Water Street** from Church Street to Weaver Street


