Boards, Bureaus, Committees, Commissions**

The City of Highland has boards, committees and commissions which advise and assist the Council in dealing with specific issues. Members are appointed by the City Council.

In accordance with the provisions of Government Code Section 54972, on or before December 31 of each year, the legislative body or City Council must post a list of all ongoing boards, committees and commissions which are appointed by the City Council. This list must include which terms will expire during the next calendar year with the name of the incumbent appointee, the date of appointment, the date the term expires, and the necessary qualifications for the positions.

Necessary Qualifications: Each member of any board, committee or commission appointed by the City Council shall be and remain a registered voter within the City, and each member shall be and remain a resident of the City during the term of appointment, unless otherwise provided. All members shall serve without compensation at the pleasure of the City Council, complete a State of Economic Interests form and complete an ethics training course pursuant to AB 1234.

**Building Code Appeals Board (Two-Year Term)**

**Meets on an As-needed Basis, Donahue Council Chambers**

Applicants shall reside within the city limits of Highland. The Building Code Appeals Board of the City of Highland consists of three (3) members and are appointed by the City Council. Two of the members shall be qualified by experience and training to pass on matters pertaining to building construction and the third member may be a lay person. The Board shall be any combination of professional individuals who are structural engineers, architects, general contractors or trade contractors. The duties of the Board shall be to hear and determine appeals of orders, decisions and determinations of the City Building Official regarding the application and interpretation of the adopted Uniform California Codes, including but not limited to, the Uniform Housing Code and the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, herein referred to as the "building code" and undue hardship appeals of orders or determinations made by the Building Official relative to Title III, Chapter 9, Subpart I) of the American with Disabilities Act, Public Law 101-336. All appointees serve without compensation, will need to complete an ethics training course pursuant to AB 1234 and will have to submit an FPPC Statement of Economic Interests form.

Meets on the second Thursday of each month for the purpose of making recommendations to the City Council regarding the development and maintenance of a community trails system within the city and its sphere of influence. Knowledge and interest in one or more of the following: equestrian activities, bicycling, hiking, nature studies or landscape/open space design. All appointees serve without compensation, will need to complete an ethics training course pursuant to AB 1234 and will have to submit an FPPC Statement of Economic Interests form.

**Historic and Cultural Preservation Board (Four-Year Term) - HMC 2.20**

**Meets First Thursday of Each Month, Donahue Council Chambers - 5:00 p.m.**

Each member of the Board shall be a resident of the city who has a demonstrated interest in or knowledge of historic preservation and the cultural resources of the city. Up to three members may be appointed from among professionals in the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, planning, or other historic preservation-related disciplines, such as urban planning, American studies, American civilization, cultural geography, or cultural anthropology, to the extent that such professionals are available in the community and wish to serve on the board. At least two members shall be lay members who have demonstrated special interest, competence, experience, knowledge in historic preservation, American studies, cultural anthropology, cultural geography, or other historic preservation-related disciplines. All appointees serve without compensation, will need to complete an ethics training course pursuant to AB 1234 and will have to submit an FPPC Statement of Economic Interests form.
