Employee of the Year. The Highland Area Chamber of Commerce hosted its 2011 Community Awards and Installation Dinner. Mayor Pro Tem Lilburn had the privilege of presenting the City of Highland Employee of the Year for 2010 Award to "the best kept secret in town" Lance Arnegard.



Lance is a model employee who has dedicated 18 years to the city and the citizens of Highland. He has worked his way through the ranks to Senior Maintenance Worker by demonstrating his ability and knowledge of department rules and procedures, establishing and maintaining effective working relationships, and leading by example. Community Development



Repete's Wisdom of the Week. Due to the recent flood that occurred in Highland, street sweeping services may be delayed due to the excessive amounts of debris and sediment left behind in the East end of the City. Extra street sweepers have been sent out to assist with this issue, so that you experience as little delay as possible.

Remember, that the street sweeper in residential areas can sweep anytime from 7 am to 5 pm, the day after your trash day. Residents are encouraged to move parked vehicles from the street on sweeping day, to ensure clean streets for Highland.



Please note that street sweeping may be halted due to inclement weather such as rain and excessive wind. Once the weather condition has subsided, your street will be swept on its regular day the following week.
