





**Repete's Wisdom of the Week -
How to Dispose of Bulky Items.** In the City of Highland each residence is allowed a free curbside pick-up two (2) times per year and up to four (4) residential bulky items (such as: couches, mattresses, furniture, appliances, etc.) per collection.

Items must be under six (6) feet and weigh less than 100lbs. If additional services are required, there will be a \$10.00 charge per item in excess of four (4) items, and/or if an additional trip must be scheduled, there will be a trip charge of \$35.00.

- If you are a customer of Burrtec Waste Industries, Inc. you may call 909-889-1969 and schedule your two free pick-ups anytime during the year.



- If you are a customer of Cal Disposal Co., Inc., free curbside pick-ups are pre-scheduled and occur two times during the year. You will receive a flyer in your trash bill prior to the scheduled pick-ups. For more information, please call 909-885-1023.

Emergency Preparedness Why Prepare? More than 82% of U.S. residents are aware that emergency preparedness is important to handle disasters. Yet of these, most have made little, if any, actual preparations! What about you? Are you ready? All of us need to take a role in helping protect each other and our families and friends in the event of an emergency. From fires to landslides to ever-present earthquakes, we continuously face emergency situations.

Disasters disrupt hundreds of thousands of lives every year. Each disaster has lasting effects, both to people and property. If a disaster occurs in your community, local government and disaster relief organizations will try to help you. But you need to be ready as well. Local responders may not be able to reach you immediately or they may need to focus their efforts elsewhere. You should know how to respond to severe weather or any disaster that could occur in your area, including earthquakes, wildfires, landslides, pandemic, flooding, terrorism and more. You should also be ready to be self-sufficient for three to seven days. This may mean providing for your own shelter, first aid, food, water and sanitation.

We know that the next emergency is coming. We just don't know when or what kind it will be.

But we can - and must - prepare now for the next emergency. Our family, friends and community depend on it.


