Street Improvement Project Begins Monday

Street Improvement Project Begins Monday!

The contractor will start setting up his operation on Monday, 3/15, to prepare for construction of the City's latest street improvement project. Construction work will follow Wednesday on Union Street. The project will construct new sidewalk on Union Street from Victoria Avenue to the end of the street east of Cunningham Street. Street repairs, crack sealing, cold milling and asphalt concrete overlay will also be completed on Union Street and on Cunningham Street from 9th Street to Cypress Street.

The project also includes street repairs, crack sealing, cold milling and asphalt concrete overlay on Elm Avenue from Jane to Byron; Byron Street from Elm to Newberry; Newberry Avenue from Jane to Byron; Jane Street from Sterling to Elm; and Miller Lane from Pacific to the northerly terminus of the street. Additionally, existing asphalt concrete pavement will be removed and replaced on Fisher Street from Elm Avenue to Osbun Road. Work in this area is schedule to begin the week of April 12th.

What's New in Public Works:

The following activities were completed by the Public Works Crew between 3/01/10 - 3/11/10: Checked for roof leaks at corporate yard, City Hall, Fire Station #1; misc. repairs at City Hall; routine maintenance at City Parks; landscape/irrigation checks & landscape maintenance districts and City facilities; made sandbags from spillway into Line F to prevent erosion and cleaned Line F; opened grate outlet from Line F pipeline into Plunge Creek area with timber; cleaned storm drains s/o Water St. and Clubview; repaired potholes at various locations (including Boulder @ Beaver Medical, Lankershim, Church St., n/o Glenheather, Gold Buckle; picked up furniture, etc. at Mira Vista, Elm St. alley, Union alley, 6th/Victoria, Base Line/Osbun, Grape St. n/o 6th; replace back-up alarm at corporate yard; marked USA tickets; asphalt repair at 5th/Palm northeast corner (at AM/PM), also on Greenspot Rd., 3rd St. w/o Palm e/o Central, Santa Ana Canyon Rd. between Weaver & Alta Vista; check generator and fire alarm problem at Fire Station #3; spray weeds on horse trails at Shelton Trail between water St. & Greenspot Rd., and Streater St. Trail by Immanuel Baptist Church and Sycamore Dr.; pickup trash and fertilized grass in dog run at Aurantia Park; clean project sign panels and put together road closure signs for Citrus Harvest Festival; dug-up bases and leveled play field



around base area at Community Park and painted backstop areas; replaced lights and ballast at baseball snack bar restrooms at Community Park; check ceiling damage at YMCA; cleaned drain on Boulder n/o Tutor Time, drain on west side of Boulder n/o Base Line, and Pulsar drain; checked surveillance cameras at parks; did PARSAC training; removed tree limb blocking traffic sign on Boulder s/o Greenspot; cleaned v-ditch along Shelton trails on Cloverhill & Easton; sprayed weeds in historical neighborhood in gutters, sidewalks, drain channels, curbs and driveways; picked-up dumped palm trees n/o 5th St., picked-up trash/tires/camper shell on Greenspot n/o City limits.
