Get Your FREE Compost on April 11th

Highland residents this is an opportunity for you to tackle those lawn and garden projects for spring. The City of Highland Public Services Division and Burrtec Waste Industries, Inc. are teaming up to host a one day compost give-a-way.

Join us on April 11, 2015 from 8:00am to 12:00 (noon) at Highland City Hall (27215 Base Line) to pick up your FREE compost.

Here is how it works:

Open to Highland Residents ONLY (proof of residency will be required).

This is a self-service program, therefore participants must provide their own shovels and assistance to load their vehicles.

Available on a first come first serve basis.

A tarp is recommended for open bed truck or trailers.

City reserves the right to end the event at any time due to product availability.

Compost can be used as a soil additive in gardens and flower beds to give plants additional nutrients and acts as a natural fertilizer. Compost helps grow stronger, healthier flowers, plants and vegetables.

Administration

The internet is a very convenient place to compare prescription drug prices, research health products and services, and learn about ways to prepare for upcoming medical appointments and procedures, but it is not always safe.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) recommends that you always speak to your doctor about any product or health service before you commit to buying it. Your doctor can tell you about the potential risks and side effects, whether or not there are studies to support the seller's claims, and the effect it will have with the medications or treatments you are currently receiving.

The FTC offers the following suggestions to help you avoid a scam:

- ◆ If you are considering buying a health related product or service online, do some research; confirm the online seller's physical address (not just a post office box) and telephone number so you can reach someone if needed.
- ◆ Do a search for the company name and website and be sure to look beyond the first page or results. Beware of negative reviews.
- ◆ Look for safety indicators to show the site is secure, such as:
 - ◆ Links to other trustworthy sites
 - ◆ The web address begins with https (the "s" stands for secure)
 - ◆ Security icons don't appear to be forged

- ◆ Avoid sites that ask you to send personal or financial information by emails, or asks you to wire cash through a money order service
- ◆ Consider the source. When you start your search for health products, services or information, consider who is behind the information.
