



## *Water Pipeline Construction on Highland Avenue*

On Tuesday, September 8, right after the Labor Day Holiday, East Valley Water District's contractor is scheduled to begin installation of a new 16" water transmission pipeline on Highland Avenue from Summertrail Place to Orchard Road. This EVWD project is being done primarily along the north side of Highland Avenue within the City of San Bernardino.

Changeable message signs have been posted on both ends of Highland Avenue in advance to alert the residents that this segment of Highland Avenue will be closed to traffic during the construction hours between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, from September 8, 2015, to October 9, 2015. Traffic from the west will be detoured to Boulder Avenue. Traffic from the east will be detoured to Church Street. Because of its narrow width, this segment of Highland Avenue needs to be closed to traffic during construction for the safety of the public as well as the construction workers.

However, it will be open to traffic every day before 8:00 a.m., and after 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and all day during the weekends. The City wishes to thank its residents in advance for their patience and cooperation during the temporary closure of Highland Avenue.

## SEPTEMBER IS NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH!

Emergency Preparedness - Preparation for Seniors. The likelihood that you and your family will recover from an emergency tomorrow often depends on the planning and preparation done today. While each person's abilities and needs are unique, every individual can take steps to prepare for all kinds of emergencies. By evaluating your own personal needs and making an emergency plan that fits those needs, you and your loved ones can be better prepared.

There are commonsense measures older Americans can take to start preparing for emergencies before they happen.

Create a network of neighbors, relatives, friends and co-workers to aid you in an emergency. Discuss your needs and make sure everyone knows how to operate necessary equipment. If appropriate, discuss your needs with your employer.

In addition to a regular emergency supplies kit, seniors should keep specialized items ready, including extra wheelchair batteries, oxygen, catheters, medication, food for service animals and any other items you might need. Keep a list of the type and model numbers of the medical devices you require, as well as medication. Be sure to make provisions for medications that require refrigeration. Make arrangements for any assistance to get to a shelter.
