

## *City Receives \$264,500 MSRC Grant*

The City's Boulder Avenue Improvement Project just got a boost in funding on 10/15/15 when the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC) of AQMD awarded a \$264,500 grant to the City.

This \$2,529,000 project will improve 2 miles of Boulder Avenue from the San Manuel Village entrance to Greenspot Road with landscaped median, parkway landscaping, sidewalk, street and bridge lighting, bikeway improvements, and pavement slurry seal. The City has recently been approved by the Federal Highway Administration for a \$2,000,000 federal grant to fund most of the project costs.

With this additional \$264,500 MSRC grant, the City's local match required for this project is essentially reduced from \$529,000 to \$264,500. The City is prepared to solicit proposals from engineering firms to begin preliminary design and environmental studies in the next couple of weeks.



## *Highland Avenue Construction Update*

For safety of the residents and EVWD's contractor, who is installing a new 16" water transmission pipeline in the narrow segment of Highland Avenue between Summertrail Place and Orchard Road, this portion of Highland Avenue has been closed to traffic between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, since Tuesday, September 8, 2015. The EVWD contractor originally estimated that the pipeline construction would be complete and Highland Avenue be opened by October 9, 2015.

However, the contractor underestimated the construction period and also encountered several unforeseen utility conflicts. As a result, the pipeline installation is now anticipated to be completed by November 6, 2015. The new extended road closure period is shown on the changeable and fixed message signs that are posted on both ends of Highland Avenue in advance of the construction zone. As before, Highland Avenue is closed between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and open to traffic every day before 8:00 a.m., and after 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday, and all day during the weekends.

Once the pipeline installation is completed by November 6, the contractor and EVWD will perform chlorination and testing of the new water pipeline, which is anticipated to take approximately one week, during which the roadway will be open to traffic. Once the chlorination and testing are completed, Highland Avenue will be closed again for an additional three days for the contractor to perform final paving and pavement striping to restore Highland Avenue to its original condition before this construction.
