America Recycles Day November 15, 2010

America Recycles Day - Nov 15, 2010. Since 1997, communities across the country have come together on November 15 to celebrate America Recycles Day. More than a celebration, America Recycles Day is the only nationally recognized day dedicated to raising awareness about the benefits of recycling and buying products made with recycled materials. Buying recycled is the step that "closes the recycling loop."



This is one day to inform and educate. One day to get our neighbors, friends and community leaders excited about what can be accomplished when we all work together. One day to make recycling bigger and better 365 days a year.

Recycle already? Looking to take it to the next level? Ramp up your recycling by taking the I Recycle Challenge:

- Calculate how your current recycling reduces your carbon footprint using the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's iWARM tool.

- Get five people you know to take the America Recycles Day pledge to recycle more.
- Host a recycling house party - teach your friends and neighbors how and what they can recycle in your community.
- Before you buy, think: reduce, reuse, and recycle. Buy products with recycled content.
- Learn how to start a recycling program (PDF) in your office, apartment building, or school.

American Recycles Day Pledge - Making a commitment to recycling is a first simple step, a declaration to do more. Be sure to take the pledge, and share it with friends and family!

- I pledge to lead by example in my place of work or school by recycling
- I pledge to recycle my used batteries, cell phones and other electronic waste through a take-back program or e-waste facility near me.

- I pledge to tell five friends that recycling is one of the easiest things they can do to reduce their carbon emissions. (Use the share button at left to get started!)
- I pledge to find out what materials I can and cannot recycle in my curbside recycling program.


