

Planning Commission: At the November 18, 2014, regular meeting, the Planning Commission considered the following item:

1. A Request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP-14-007) to Modify the Alcoholic Beverage Control License for an Existing Non-Conforming Convenience Store with a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer and Wine) License to a Type 21 (Off-Sale General) License and Extend the Hours of Operation

The Planning Commission: Adopted Resolution No. 14-018 for denial of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP-14-009) to modify the Alcoholic Beverage Control License for an existing non-

conforming convenience store with a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer and Wine) license to a Type 21 (Off-Sale General) license and extend the hours of operation and;

1. Adopted the Findings of Fact.

Residential Rental Enhancement Program Temporarily Enhanced - In September, the City Council approved a temporary pilot program to assist the Residential Rental Enhancement Program. As of October 28th, we have hired a new temporary Code Enforcement Officer/Building Inspector and installed a new automated permit tracking system, making its kick-off official!



As part of the pilot program, the City is working with John Baker from Wildan and Associates. John will help the City's Code Enforcement Team implement the City's Residential Rental Enhancement Program by locating rental properties in the City and conducting inspections of each rental unit ensuring they comply with current health and safety codes. John has been a licensed contractor for 26 years, has been in the construction field for 30 years, and was initially hired by Wildan and Associates to assist cities with building inspection services.

"I'm motivated to get things started and issues resolved to help the City maintain its rental house stock," says John on his first day on the job. The pilot program will be evaluated in four (4) months with a detailed report provided to the City Council soon thereafter. If you see John, stop by and say hello. *Welcome aboard John!*
