

How do I handle excess holiday packaging?



Even with the best reduce-reuse-recycle efforts, the holidays may still generate more waste than your recycling cart can handle. So, Cal Disposal and Burrtec Waste

Industries, Inc. have come up with a simple solution to help Highland residents avoid improper disposal of recyclable holiday packaging.

Any recyclable holiday packaging, for example: gift boxes, cardboard packaging, wrapping paper (non-foil based), tissue paper, greeting cards, etc. that will not fit within your blue roll cart will be collected from the curb on your regular collection day at no extra charge!

► **Burrtec customers** may put out any excess holiday recyclables for two weeks beginning **December 26, 2009 to January 9, 2010.**

► **Cal Disposal customers** may put out any excess holiday recyclables during the week of **December 28, 2009 to January 2, 2010.**

Remember, only recyclable items will be picked up. Be sure and place the excess recyclable

items at the curb on your regular collection day during the specified week(s) no later than 6am. If you plan to use a bag for those excess items, please make sure the contents can be easily identified as recyclable.

Here is how you can:

Simply place your Christmas tree at the curb on your regular collection day.



❖ Burrtec customers, place your trees out from **December 26th - January 9th**

❖ Cal Disposal customers, place your trees out from **January 4th - January 8th**

- Trees over 6ft must be cut in half.

- Please remove all tinsel, ornaments, plastic, bags, stands, braces, wire and nails.
- No artificial, flocked or fireproofed trees will be accepted.
